Dear NERSBA Scholar:

As you are aware, one of our goals at NERSBA is to instill leadership and integrity throughout our program of study. Since our school focuses on the premises of FFA, we have embraced the importance of leaders contributing back to their communities. On Friday, September 29, 2017, we will be observing our first opportunity to volunteer in our community. As with Home Satellite Days, you have certain requirements to complete with regards to this scheduled day in our NERSBA calendar. I have outlined below the criteria for this assignment.

1. Complete 6 total hours for the day.
2. Volunteering in your community does NOT include “chores” that you may have at home OR your paid position for work purposes.
3. Signed time sheet from your supervisor(s).
4. Submit a description of what you did – using correct grammar and punctuation with 12 point font, Times New Roman, and double space. This should be at least 1 page long which includes the following:
  - a. A description of the activity(ies) that you volunteered to complete in your community;
  - b. A description of how your efforts impacted the community; and
  - c. A description of how this experience affected you as a leader in your community (reflect on the FFA Creed and what it means to be a leader in this description).
5. All submissions MUST be done through CANVAS by logging into your SAE course in PowerSchool.
6. In addition, you may also submit these hours into AET to count towards your SAE requirements as outlined in your Scholar Manual.
7. The DEADLINE for submissions to CANVAS is SUNDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2017 at 11:59 p.m. (EST). Please see any staff member for suggestions and ideas on volunteer opportunities.
